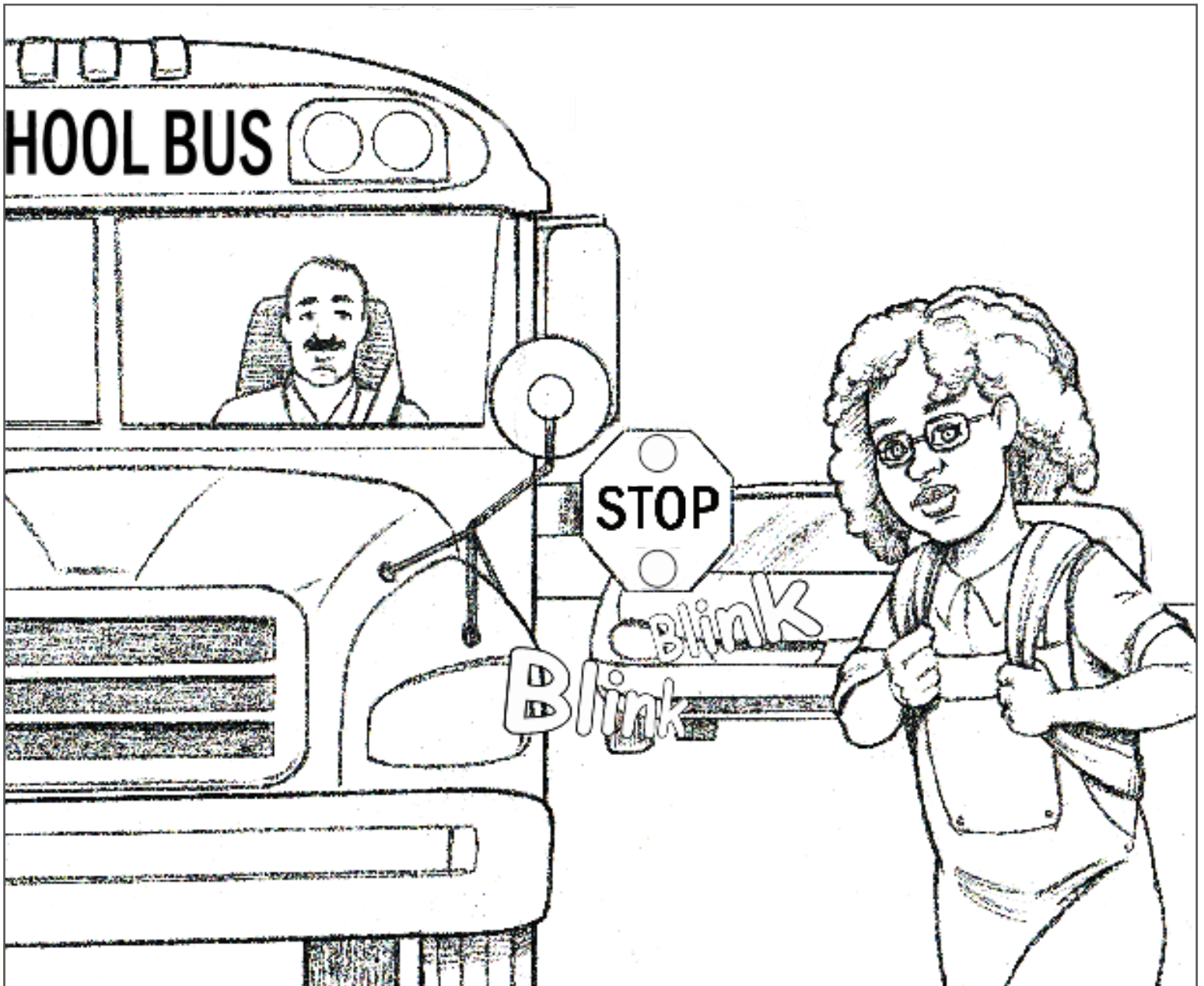




The bus driver stops the bus before reaching us and opens the door.

Safety tip: Always take the bus. It's the safest way to get to school.
